



**USAG FORT HUNTER LIGGETT & PARKS RESERVE FORCES TRAINING AREA WEAPONS REGISTRATION AGREEMENT**

**The carrying of a concealed weapon on the installation is prohibited regardless of whether a state or county permit has been obtained. Per AR 190-11, a concealed weapon is any instrument used or designed for the purpose of inflicting grievous bodily harm that is carried on the person in such a way as to be hidden from ordinary view. Folded knives with blades shorter than 3 inches are excluded from this definition.**

I understand that in accordance with AR 190-11 to verify individuals are not prohibited from owning a firearm, all individuals who want to register a firearm will have a criminal history conducted to determine eligibility. I understand that if I have been convicted of one of the following that I will not be able to bring or register my weapon on Fort Hunter Liggett or Parks Reserve Forces Training Area.

AR 190-11, para 4-5.c.:

(4) The registration of privately owned firearms by person(s) described below is prohibited:

(a) Any person convicted of a felony (Gun Control Act of 1968 (Title 18, United States Code, Section 921 et seq. (18 USC 921 et seq.), as amended in 1996 (18 USC 922).

(b) Any person convicted in any court of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence or a felony (the Lautenberg Amendment to the Federal Gun Control Act of 1968, as amended in 1996).

The Amendment:

1. Makes it a felony for any person to sell or otherwise dispose of firearms or ammunition to any person he or she knows or has reasonable cause to believe has been convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence.

2. Prohibits anyone who has been convicted of a misdemeanor crime of domestic violence from shipping or transporting in interstate or foreign commerce, or possessing in or affecting commerce, any firearm or ammunition; or receiving any firearm or ammunition which has been shipped or transported in interstate or foreign commerce.

(c) Any person who is a fugitive from justice.

(d) Any person who has been convicted in any court of the possession, use, or sale of marijuana, dangerous or narcotic drugs (the term convicted includes nonjudicial punishment under Uniform Code of Military Justice (UCMJ), Article 15).

(e) Any person who is presently declared as mentally incompetent or who is presently committed to any mental institution.

(f) Any civilian or Family member under the age of 18 is prohibited from the use of firearms, unless accompanied and supervised by a parent or legal guardian over the age of 18.

Hunter weapons registration requirement

(1) Only hunters entering main cantonment are required to register firearms. Firearms registration will be requested no later than 14 days in advance to account for processing time. Failure to do so, may result in denial of access to the cantonment area.

Storage of privately owned firearms and ammunition

(1) Firearms belonging to Soldiers living in unit billets (barracks) must be secured in the unit arms room in approved locked containers separate from military AA&E.

(2) Firearms belonging to personnel residing in leased housing will be secured in either a locked container or provided with a trigger lock. Ammunition for the firearm will be secured separately from the firearm in a locked container.

(3) Hunters staying at on post lodging must ensure weapons are properly secured in a locked case always separate from ammunition.

Transportation of privately owned firearms and ammunition on Army installations:

(1) Privately owned firearms will be transported in vehicles only while traveling in a direct route to and from hunting areas or other location authorized by the installation senior commander. No stops are authorized.

(2) The carrying of a loaded firearm in a vehicle is prohibited.

(3) Privately owned firearms carried in a vehicle will be secured in the trunk. For vehicles without a trunk, firearms will be encased in a container other than the glove compartment and carried in such a manner that they will not be readily available to the driver or passengers. Commercially available trigger locks and other security devices are strongly recommended to deter and prevent loss and theft.

(4) If requested by installation law enforcement personnel, individuals will present the registration document when the firearm is out of an approved storage location and being transported on the installation.

I have read the above statement and realize that by signing block 16, below that I am willing to submit to a criminal history check on myself to determine my eligibility. I also understand that failure to do so will result in me not being able to register my weapon on the installation.

**INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING FHL FORM 8-1**

1. All firearms brought onto the installation by residing residents, will be registered within 24 hours with the DES, Visitor Control Center (VCC) IAW AR 190-11 (Note: Firearms will not be transported inside the registration building). Visiting persons must register weapons at least 14 days in advance.
2. Soldiers are required to have their unit commander complete and sign the unit commander's (Block 18) portion of this form. Authorized dependents will require sponsor's signature. Civilian employees living and working on the installation are required to obtain Deputy Garrison Commander signature in (Block 18).
3. Registration may be completed by:
  - a. Manual - Complete form and hand carry to the FHL/PRFTA Visitor Control Center (VCC) Mon-Thu 0700-1330.
  - b. Automated - digitally sign and send the completed form to: [usarmy.hunterliggett.id-readiness.mbx.des-vcc@army.mil](mailto:usarmy.hunterliggett.id-readiness.mbx.des-vcc@army.mil)  
Once completed, owner will receive registration via return e-mail.
4. Registration is not complete until the information is entered into the Army Law Enforcement Reporting & Tracking System (ALERTS).
5. If more space is required provide a continuation sheet with all required information.
