SUBJECT: Updated Mask Guidelines for Vaccinated Personnel

1. References:

2. Scope. This policy applies to all personnel who live, work, or visit USAG FHL.

3. General. The purpose of this policy is to provide updated guidance on the wear of Personal Protective Equipment (face masks) for personnel working, residing, training, and visiting USAG FHL.

4. Effective immediately, fully vaccinated individuals, defined as those who are at least two weeks beyond their final dose of Pfizer or Moderna, or two weeks beyond a single dose of Johnson and Johnson, are no longer required to wear a mask indoors or outdoors in USAG FHL facilities. Exceptions to this policy include the child development center, medical and dental facilities, COVID-19 vaccination sites, and the PX and the Commissary where masks must continue to be worn.

5. The following facilities are still required to follow Sec Def memo "Use of Masks and Other Public Health Measures" dated 04 February 2021: FHL Child Development Center, Fort Hunter Liggett Aid Station, FHL and Parks Reserve Forces Training Center (PRFTA) Visitor Control Centers, the FHL and PRFTA Post Exchanges, and the FHL Commissary. These facilities are required to maintain signage requiring mask usage.

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6. Any individual indoors at USAG FHL who is not fully vaccinated must continue to wear a mask indoors in accordance with previous DoD and USAG FHL mask guidance.
7. Commanders and supervisors should not ask about an employee's vaccination status to make decisions about how and when employees will report to a workplace instead of teleworking.
8. Exception to Policy. Directors may make written recommendations to me for exceptions to this policy to ensure a safe and ready workforce.
9. This policy will be disseminated to the lowest level.
