- To transfer to another Hunt Area or Fishing Pond, the new Hunt Area or Pond and time of the transfer must be entered on the "Hunt Area /Pond Transferred Into" line.
- Hunters are authorized to use only approved weapons for the Hunt Area they check into. The hunter is responsible for being familiar with the approved weapon type for each Hunt Area used. - Report harvest during check-out.
- FHL Hunting and Fishing Program operates under and enforces the California Fish and Game Code.
